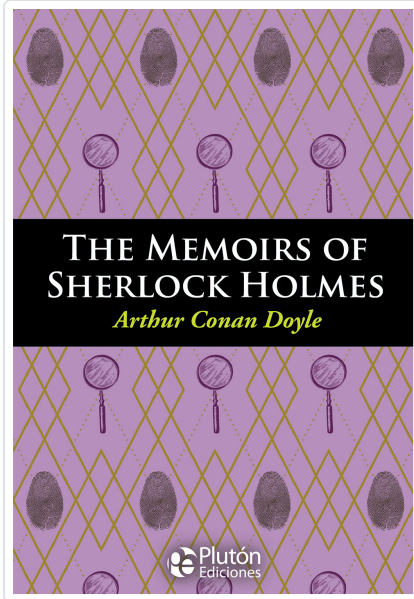


# THE MEMORIES OF SHERLOCK HOLMES. English

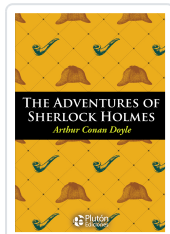
## SINOPSIS

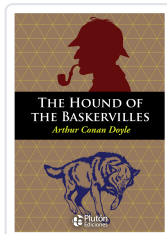

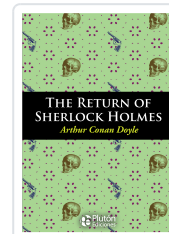
